# PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING POLICY

This policy by Wellesbourne Wanderers addresses photography and filming of children in football to celebrate participation while ensuring their wellbeing.

## Purpose

To effectively manage photography and filming in order to safeguard children.

## Scope:

This policy applies to Club official, coaches, volunteers, parents, carers, and external photographers.

## Guiding Principles

- To promote positive images.
- Ensure respectful and appropriate photography.
- Prioritize child safety and privacy.

## Consent and Permissions

The Club will obtain written consent from parents/carers before capturing or publishing images through the registration process, this can be rescinded at any time upon request

## Acceptable Use

- Children dressed appropriately (shirt/vest and shorts).
- Focus on activities, prefer group shots, and no names without consent.

## Unacceptable Use

- No filming in changing areas.
- No misuse of images or personal information.
- No images of children with jewelry during activities.

## Filming for Coaching:

Coaches can film for training; parents and players will be informed, and footage will be stored securely.

**Working with External Media:** Media must be briefed on safeguarding and wear visible ID; consent forms must be checked.

## Reporting Concerns:

Report misuse of images or safeguarding issues to the Club Welfare Officer.

**\*\*Legal Considerations\*\*:** Photography in public is allowed, but the club can restrict image-taking on its premises.
